Introducing Peepal

Peepal Foundation, initiated in 2001, was the brainchild of a few altruistically-minded professionals who recognized the need for change among underprivileged populations in cities throughout India. Eager to turn this need into interventions that had real-life impacts, these individuals began by creating a daycare for low-income labourers in Hadaspar, which then spread to other cities across India, thus introducing the first Peepal intervention.

Since this conceptualizing moment, Peepal has grown, and thus shifted their intervention into a program that provides sustained education for underprivileged children from the communities they serve. This is where the Child Education, Development and Empowerment (CEDE) program comes in, an intervention that targets developing a child's personality, knowledge, and skills through holistic means. Specifically, Peepal's CEDE program includes a 60 hour per semester curriculum that is integrated into a normal school scheduled, designed to focus on areas such as communication, active citizenship, leadership and teamwork, and art and culture. This is executed through different modules of teaching, experiential learning, and intensively trained individuals titled change-managers who assist the students throughout the year. Other initiatives, such as Teacher Trainings and Empowerment Workshops for parents and school authorities, ensure that the entire community is taking part in the change process for these youth.

Through the CEDE initiative, Peepal provides children from these low-income populations with the opportunity to grow into well-rounded, multi-skilled individuals who have the capacity to become successful, educated and impactful adults.

Why work with us?

At Peepal, we implement interventions that initiate real change within low-income groups. Peepal is an organization that is established in the communities it works in, and the change that we have created is visible in our student's assessment scores, behaviors and confidence levels. By working with Peepal, the candidate will have the opportunity to see first hand the impact that they are making in the communities that need it most and gain inspiration from these experiences. While Peepal is an established organization, we are currently undergoing change and growth, and the candidate will be a major stakeholder in the initiatives that are developed and established in Peepal's future. The candidate will have the opportunity to implement their vision for Peepal and the people the company impacts, and grow as an individual alongside the organization.
